The continued success of our teams on a conference, state, regional and national level was highlighted in 2007 - 08 with National Championship Tournament appearances by two teams as well as 10 individual athletes that represented the "Green and Gold" at the National Championship competition. The gymnastics team finished second at the NCGA National Championship meet, and the women's basketball team advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament in March. Individual athletes represented Brockport at national championships in cross country, wrestling, indoor track and field and outdoor track and field. There were 14 All-America awards and two National Champions in 2007-08.

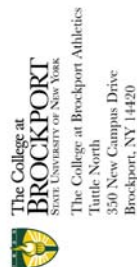

September 6 – Football kicks off the 2008 season with its first-ever New Jersey Athletic Conference game on Bob Boozer Field at Special Olympics Stadium. Game time is 1 pm.

September 20 – Women's Soccer celebrates 25 years with a special ceremony at halftime of the home opener against Buffalo State. Game time is 1 pm.

October 4 – The annual Homecoming Weekend celebration is highlighted by a parade through town, Brockport's football game against Rowan University, field hockey against SUNY Oneonta, men's soccer against SUNY New Paltz and women's tennis takes on SUNY Cortland.
