

Sample #5 – Non-matriculated, graduate, New York State resident
Registered for 12 undergraduate credits
Dropped 3 credits during second week of classes
Added 3 new credits during second week of classes

- Original tuition charge – \$2,175

\$ 181	per credit tuition rate
<u>x 12</u>	credits
\$2,172	

At 12 credits, the **minimum amount**, which can be charged is the full time undergraduate rate of \$2,175

Adjusted tuition charge after dropping and adding:

- Remaining courses

<u>x 3</u>	credits
\$543	
- Total Adjusted Tuition

\$1,629.00	remaining courses
+ 162.90	dropped course
<u>+ 543.00</u>	added course
\$2,334.90	adjusted tuition

Full time undergraduate rate of \$2,175 does **not** apply.

Non-matriculated graduate students at 12 or more credits are charged a minimum of the full undergraduate rate and a maximum of the full time graduate rate.
