

Referendum on Course Scheduling

On November 15, 2010, the College Senate rejected the resolution in Senate Proposal #06 10-11GC/UC “Modifications of the Existing Course Schedule Time Blocks”. In accordance with the Article XI of the Bylaws of the Faculty of The College at Brockport, the College Senate office has received a petition signed by a sufficient number of Faculty to initiate a referendum on this action of the Senate:

WHEREAS the Academic Affairs Taskforce on Course Scheduling has crafted three Models for modifying course scheduling practices, and

WHEREAS the Provost recommended and sought Senate support for implementation of the 50 minute MWF, 75 minute TR, 15 minute transit time Model, and

WHEREAS the Provost requested a Senate recommendation as to which 50/75/15 Model (a or b) should be implemented, and

WHEREAS the Senate Undergraduate and Graduate Curriculum Committees voted to support the 50/75/15 Model b (no late Friday classes), therefore be it

RESOLVED that the College Senate endorses the 50/75/15 Model b (no late Friday classes), and be it further

RESOLVED that the College Senate fully endorses the recommendation of the Taskforce on the provisions that ongoing support be provided to faculty and students to facilitate student learning, and be it further

RESOLVED that guidelines governing class scheduling and the allocation of teaching space be developed.
