Teacher candidates must be enrolled in the EDI 445-449 Inclusive Middle Level Teaching course in the fall semester be in good academic standing, particularly in education courses, and submit a written request clearly expressing your particular situation. All teacher candidates enrolled in EDI 445-449 in the fall semester who have not completed EDI 414 will receive email notification of the process or around <b>November 1</b>. Your request will be reviewed by a department committee and candidates will be notified by the third Monday in November. Requests will be reviewed only in the fall semester, apply to candidates who have not completed EDI 414 Methods in Special Education and cite extenuating circumstances for completing two courses each requiring 50 hours of field placement in the upcoming spring semester.</p> <p><b>**Course requires a 50 hr field experience.
