A sixteen-month format-- September 1, 2011 through December 31, 2012

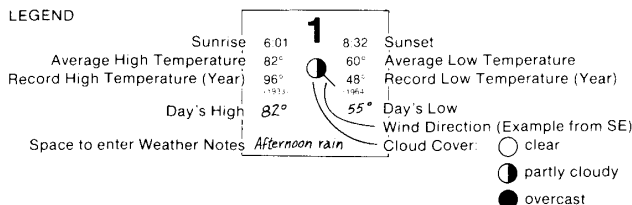
Daily records updated through June 30, 2011.

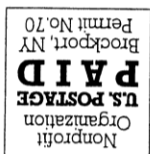
