

How and when financial aid will be disbursed

The following is a checklist of what needs to be completed before we can process and disburse financial aid:

- Packaged by the Financial Aid Office
- Registered for courses
- Accept or decline financial aid package on the Web
- Affirmed enrollment and accepted financial responsibility by the required due date
- Signed promissory note(s) and completed entrance interview session if receiving loans

Once the above is completed:

- The college then applies last aid received to the student bill
- The loan refund process may start (check or *direct deposit) as early as 10 days before each semester begins
- Federal Pell Grant will be determined after the semester credit census date (three weeks and one day into the semester)
- TAP will be certified and approved by the state

*SUNY Brockport offers a direct deposit option to students that enable the Office of Student Accounts to distribute the financial aid refund directly into your checking or savings account. One of the main advantages of enrolling in the direct deposit program will be decreased amount of time to receive funds due to mailing delays.
