Instructions:

Non-degree status provides the opportunity for students to enroll on a non-matriculated basis in graduate courses for which they have the prerequisites and interest. Applications must be accompanied by a one-time payment of \$25. You must also provide an official transcript in a sealed envelope documenting receipt of a baccalaureate (or higher) degree from a regionally accredited institution no later than 30 days from the start of your first semester in non-degree status. SUNY Brockport graduates are not required to submit transcripts of their work completed at SUNY Brockport.

Students who plan to later apply for admission into a graduate program should consult with the department before enrolling for courses. Courses taken in non-degree status will not necessarily be accepted later in a degree program. A maximum of nine credits taken in non-degree status may, with departmental approval, be credited towards a graduate degree program.
