- I. The History Major.** The major consists of **36** credits in History courses, **18** of which must be at the upper division (300-400) level and taken at Brockport. Only courses in which a grade of "C" or higher is received are accepted as meeting these requirements.

Students entering the College as transfers with junior status may be exempted from HST 201 and 202 (formerly 101 and 102) if they have completed 6 credits in Western Civilization at another institution.

- PSH 384 & PRO 370 require a grade  $\geq$  C.
- EDI courses require a grade  $\geq$  C+ for program continuation.
- EDI 413 is the pre-requisite for EDI 414 and EDI 419.
- EDI 430 may be taken in any phase prior to student teaching.
- All remaining courses must be taken concurrently in their specified phases.
- Cumulative Brockport GPA  $\geq$  2.5 required for program continuation.
- **\*\*EDI 330, EDI 414 and EDI 417** require a 50 hour field experience.
