- I. The History Major.** The major consists of at least **36** credits in History courses, **18** of which must be at the upper division (300-400) level and taken at Brockport. Only courses in which a grade of "C" or higher is received are accepted as meeting these requirements. No more than 54 History credits will be counted

Students entering the College as transfers with junior status may be exempted from HST 201 and 202 (formerly 101 and 102) if they have completed 6 credits in Western Civilization at another institution.
