Policy:

The State University of New York College at Brockport expresses and demonstrates its commitment to equal opportunity for all persons in the college community, regardless of race, color, sex, age, ethnicity, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, disability, marital status, or status of Vietnam-era, special disabled, recently separated, or other protected veteran. This policy applies to all college offices, departments, and affiliates, students, faculty, and staff members.
