

## Information on application to the nursing program for students who are currently taking courses at The College at Brockport

Students in this category may be one of two types:

1. Students who are considered to be native Brockport students are –
  - those who have not been enrolled in any other college prior to entering Brockport, (may have earned AP credit while in high school)
  - will generally have completed 3 semesters at Brockport at the time of application to the nursing program

Review the “School of Nursing Admission Requirements” which can be found on the Department of Nursing webpage. This document contains information about eligibility, GPA requirements, and prerequisite completion requirements.

The application for consideration to the nursing program will be available from the webpage during the first week of November, 2011. Applicants must print, complete, and submit the application to the Nursing Department no later than 3:00 pm on January 20, 2012. You are not required to submit any other documents (transcripts, DARS) with your application.

2. Students who are considered to be transfer students are either:
  1. those who have transferred to Brockport from another college and will have earned at least 12 credits at Brockport by the end of the fall 2011 semester

Students having earned 12 or more credit hours at Brockport at the time of application to the nursing program will be evaluated as a native student.

Review the “School of Nursing Admission Requirements” which can be found on the Department of Nursing webpage. This document contains information about eligibility, GPA requirements, and prerequisite completion requirements.

The application for consideration to the nursing program will be available from the webpage during the first week of November, 2011. Applicants must print, complete, and submit the application to the Nursing Department no later than 3:00 pm on January 20, 2012. You are not required to submit any other documents (transcripts, DARS) with your application.

or

2. those who have transferred to Brockport from another college and will have earned less than 12 credits at Brockport by the end of the fall 2011 semester

Students having earned less than 12 credit hours at Brockport at the time of application to the nursing program will be evaluated as a direct transfer student.
