

Information on application to the nursing program for students who are NOT currently taking courses at The College at Brockport – (Direct Transfer Students)*

Students in this category are considered to be “direct transfer students” and may be one of two types:

1. students who are currently not taking courses at Brockport, and if accepted by the college and the Nursing Department, will enter the nursing program in the fall of 2012, having met all criteria for eligibility at another college, or at The College at Brockport after the time of application but before September 1, 2012, or
2. *students who are currently taking courses at Brockport, but will have earned less than 12 credits at Brockport at the time of application to the nursing program.

Students in the above categories:**

- may have not yet applied to the college, or have recently applied for admission to the college,
- may have not taken any courses at Brockport,
- may be completing an Associate’s degree in May or August of 2012 at another college
- may have earned an Associate’s, Baccalaureate, or Master’s degree previously
- may be currently taking courses at Brockport but will not have earned 12 credits by the time of application

**not inclusive of all circumstances

Criteria for eligibility for direct transfer students to apply to the nursing program:

1. If not already accepted by The College at Brockport, must apply for admission to the college no later than January 1, 2012,
2. Must have a transfer GPA of 3.0 or higher, (those students already accepted by the college and currently taking courses at Brockport must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher),
3. Must submit a completed nursing program application by 3:00 pm on January 20, 2012, (you will not need to submit transcripts with your nursing application)
4. Must have all nursing prerequisites completed by the beginning of the fall 2012 semester, with a minimum grade of “C”, (may take up to 2 nursing prerequisites over the summer, 2012 semester)
5. Must have a minimum of 54 non-nursing liberal arts credits earned by the beginning of the fall 2012 semester.

NOTE:

Admission to the nursing program is extremely competitive. Admission to The College at Brockport does **not** guarantee admission into the nursing program.
