Majors will take an additional 21 credit hours in PLS courses, at least 15 of which must be at the upper division (300/400) level. A minimum of one course must be taken from each of the following sub-fields: American Politics, Political Theory, Comparative Politics, and International Relations.

Internships such as the Washington Semester Program, the Albany Internship Programs (Assembly, Senate and Albany Semester), and the Legal Internship offer upper division credit in Political Science. In addition, the Albany Internship pays a stipend.

MINOR IN POLITICAL SCIENCE

The minor requires completion of two of the four required 100 and 200 level courses (6 credit hours). Minors must also take twelve credits of upper division (300/400 level) course work, for a total of 18 credits in Political Science.
