



**OVERVIEW:** An explanation of the grounds for de-matriculation at the graduate level.

The College at Brockport has delineated and published a number of key policies designed to encourage students' continued and timely progress through their degree programs. Students may lose their matriculated status for failure to comply with these key policies, including:

- Failure to file a *Plan of Study* within the first semester of matriculated status
- Failure to complete the degree program within five years (or seven years for Public Administration and Mental Health Counseling)
- Failure to enroll in a course every twelve months to maintain continuous enrollment in their graduate program

Once de-matriculated, a student who wished to continue graduate study at The College at Brockport would be required to apply for readmission to the graduate program.
