Good Samaritan Actions

The College does not condone violations of the “Code of Student Social Conduct” or state and federal law. However, efforts, including limited immunity to campus judicial charges, will be made to mitigate sanctions associated with alcohol and other drug offenses for “Good Samaritans.”

A “Good Samaritan” is a student who provides assistance to a person in need of medical attention by taking steps to summon aid where the individual summoning the aid may have contributed or participated in the use and abuse of alcohol or other drugs.
