Grade Point Average (GPA) at the Graduate Level

For students admitted fall 2003 or later, all graduate courses completed and/or attempted are included in determining a graduate student's official semester and cumulative GPA. The cumulative GPA is calculated at the end of the spring, summer, and fall semesters. An overall cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 is required for graduation.
