Mid-term grades are provided for undergraduate students only. Such grades are a progress report for the undergraduate student to serve as an evaluation of the quality of the work to date. Mid-term grades are not recorded and do not become part of the permanent record.

Each semester, mid-term grades will be available [online](#) at *Student Services and Financial Aid* and then *Student Records*. Because the system asks each student to provide a social security number or Banner ID, as well as a personal identification number (PIN), grade records remain confidential.

Please keep in mind that a financial obligation (hold) to the College will prevent students from gaining access to their grades as well as other services. Students must contact the appropriate department or office to clear it.
