### **Residence Hall License**

This license contains all information about Residential Life/Learning Communities policies, including but not limited to the following:

- Detailed list of prohibited items
- Alcohol and Other Substances Policies
- Smoking Policy – Smoking is prohibited in or within 25 feet of any residence hall.
- Occupancy conditions – License is binding for the entire academic year.
- Occupancy information - housing charges and termination of occupancy information
- Quiet hours – Sunday through Thursday (7:00pm to 7:00am) and Friday through Saturday (midnight to 7:00am). 24-hour courtesy hours.
- Health and Safety guidelines
- Furniture and facility damages and charges
- Residence hall access – keys, ID cards, and guest policy
