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## Frequently Asked Questions

### What is a club sport?

A club sport is a recognized organization that has been formed by interested students who have a desire to participate in a sport or recreational activity. Each club is a student run organization that may seek outside organizational assistance.

### What is the goal of club sports?

Each club exists to provide members with leadership and development opportunities.



### How many club sports are currently active at The College of Brockport?

There are 16 active club sports at the college. These clubs include: Cheerleading, Capoeira, Dance, Judo, Men's Gymnastics, Men's Rugby, Women's Rugby, Men's Tennis, Men's Volleyball, Paintball, Roller Hockey, Ski, Synchronized Skating, Tae Kwon Do, Ultimate Frisbee, and Women's Ice Hockey.

### Are club sports considered varsity?

No, club sports are not varsity sports but they do participate in competitions and tournaments.

### What are the requirements of the club sport teams?

Each club is required to complete a minimum of one community service project per academic year, as well as two fundraising projects per year. The money collected from the fundraisers goes into the club account for their use. Members of these club sports are restricted to enrolled College at Brockport students who have paid the Brockport Student Government Fee.

### Are there "tryouts" for club sports?

Although individuals cannot be "cut" from a club, it may be necessary for a club to hold try-outs to determine the ability of a participant. Based on these tryouts club officers place team members on "competition teams" as well as "A" or "B" teams.

### Do the clubs collect dues?

According to BSG policy, clubs are not allowed to collect dues from its members. However clubs may

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
