# Is Your Room Safe?

**A Fire Inspection Team will be checking student rooms in early February.**

**The following items are prohibited:**

-  Overloading electrical outlets
-  Use of extension cords
-  Overuse of power plug strips (plugging multiple strips together)
-  Use of cooking devices that produce grease such as:  
Foreman grills, hot plates, crockpots
-  Halogen lamps, heat lamps, torchiere lamps
-  Candles or incense
-  Posters, paper, materials covering more than 20% of the wall



**Per the 2010-2011 Residence Hall License Item F - Entry:** “In keeping with the terms, conditions, duties, standards, obligations, and other applicable provisions of this document, and in the interest of the health, safety, and general welfare of the College community, the Residence Halls, and each and every one of their assigned occupants and the authorized guests thereof, the College reserves the right to enter and inspect student rooms and/or suites, and all other areas in College Residence Halls at any reasonable time including but not limited to: before all academic recess periods after giving oral and/or written notice of its intention to do so to any occupant or occupants then physically present in the rooms, and/or suites or other areas to be so entered and inspected.”
