

Living Learning Community  
Student Conduct Process  
2011-2012

For Living Learning Community Students in First-Year Halls:

1. Meet with your RD as required. If you are found responsible for the incident, you must:
2. **Within one week of your incident**, call 585-395-2122 to schedule a 30-minute appointment with the Coordinator of Living Learning Communities to discuss your community sanction.
3. Community sanctions will be created collaboratively to maximize the learning experience and may include but are not limited to:
  - a. assisting the RA or LLC Mentors with tasks
  - b. attending targeted programming
  - c. community service (to be scheduled with the Office of Community Development the Office of Health Promotions/Prevention Services as appropriate)
  - d. creating bulletin boards for your floor
  - e. writing reflection papers
4. Complete all required sanctions by the end of the semester (dependant on the date of your incident) and follow up with staff as required.

*\*\*Please note: Community sanctions are in addition to any assigned conduct probation and/or educational workshops you may be required to attend.*

Students will be tracked by the Coordinators of Living Learning Communities and Student Conduct collaboratively. Any student who fails to complete sanctions within one semester will meet with the Coordinator of Living Learning Communities to discuss his/her future in the LLCs.

Learning Outcomes

Living Learning Community students who break student code of conduct will be able to:

- Process their choices and actions
- Establish future action plans for success
- Recall and practice information gained as a result from sanctioned activities
- Determine the impact of choices on self, others and the larger community (LLC)

Assessment Tools

- Adapted student conduct discussion form
- Sanction completion rubric
- Follow-up survey or meeting, depending on the case
- Recidivism numbers
