Application Package for The Class of 1953 Scholarship 2010-2011

The Class of 1953 Scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate student enrolled in one of The College at Brockport's teacher certification programs. It is designed to recognize his or her commitment to and potential for excellence in a teaching career. The recipient must demonstrate significant involvement in the community and schools.

The Class of 1953 graduated from the College when it was known as State University of New York, Teachers College at Brockport. Students were involved in one of two teacher preparation programs: General Elementary Education or Physical Education and Health. Most of the class went on to become effective and influential teachers and educators. It is for that reason, the Class of 1953, to honor its 50th graduation anniversary, establishes this scholarship. We wish to recognize the importance of teachers in our society by supporting a deserving student aspiring to teach.

ELIGIBILITY

- Currently enrolled, matriculated undergraduate student
- Enrolled full-time or part-time (6 credits a semester minimum)
- Accepted into one of the College's teacher certification programs
- Institutional GPA of at least 3.0 at time of application

CRITERIA

- Demonstrate a commitment to and potential for excellence in a teaching career as determined by the selection committee in the review process.
- Complete the Class of 1953 Application Form and return it to the Scholarship Office by the announced deadline.
- Submit an essay, not to exceed two typed pages, describing your reasons for wanting a career in teaching, highlighting significant involvement in the community and schools, and, summarizing why you deserve this scholarship.
- Request recommendation forms for this scholarship from three (3) professors, one being a professor in your certification program.

To be considered for this \$1,000 scholarship, your completed application, essay and three letters of recommendation must be received in the Office of Alumni Relations & Development, 216 Allen Building, on or before March 12, 2010.
