



## Application Package Class of 1962 Scholarship 2010-2011

The Class of 1962 Scholarship is awarded to an undergraduate student enrolled in one of The College at Brockport's teacher certification programs. It is designed to recognize his or her commitment to and potential for excellence in a teaching career. The recipient must demonstrate significant involvement in the community and schools.

The Class of 1962 graduated from the College when it was known as State University of New York, Teachers College at Brockport. Students were involved in one of two teacher preparation programs: General Elementary Education or Physical Education and Health. Many graduates became effective and influential teachers, educators and leaders. It is for that reason, the Class of 1962 establishes this scholarship. The class wishes to recognize the importance of teachers in our society by supporting an outstanding student aspiring to teach.

### **ELIGIBILITY and CRITERIA**

1. Students must:
  - a. Be a matriculated undergraduate student
  - b. Be enrolled either full-time or part-time (6 credits a semester minimum)
  - c. Be accepted into one of the college's teacher certification programs:
    1. Childhood Inclusive Education (Grades 1-6)
    2. Physical Education Pre-K-12
    3. Health Pre-K-12
    4. Secondary Teachers' certification areas:

a. Biology	b. Chemistry	c. Earth Science
d. English	e. French	f. Math
g. Physics	h. Social Studies	i. Spanish
  - d. Demonstrate academic proficiency at the time of application
  - e. Demonstrate a commitment to and potential for excellence in a teaching career as determined by the selection committee in the review process
  - f. Complete the Class of 1962 Application Form and return it to the Office of Alumni Relations & Development by the announced deadline
  - g. Submit an essay, not to exceed two typed pages, describing the reasons for wanting a career in teaching, highlighting significant involvement in the community and schools, and summarizing why the candidate qualifies for this scholarship
  - h. Request recommendations for this scholarship from three professors, one being a professor in the certification program
  - i. Be enrolled as an undergraduate in the year following the award.

**To be considered for this scholarship, your completed application, essay and three letters of recommendation must be received in the Office of Alumni Relations & Development, 216 Allen Building, on or before December 11, 2009.**
