Dear Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Newman Scholarship. In this packet you will find an application form and three (3) forms for letters of recommendation. Here's what you will need to make your application complete:

- A completed application form.
- An essay (500 words, typed), which includes biographical data and information supporting your eligibility for this scholarship. Your essay can significantly help you become a scholarship recipient. The committee uses information about academic achievement, volunteer activities as well as how your faith life interacts with this, to help them in the selection process. Be sure to cover these things thoroughly in your essay.
- Three letters of recommendation, one of which should be from a pastor, youth minister or other person in ministry who knows you well.
- If you do not attend Mass at Newman, we will also need a letter from your pastor, youth minister or other person on the staff of your parish indicating that you are an active member of the parish.
- Current copy of your official academic transcript.

All materials are due by **March 12, 2010**. They will then be forwarded to the Newman Scholarship Committee for review. Send your completed application materials to:
