Faculty Services at Drake

Services most relevant for online teaching:

- **How to link to Library Content (articles, movies) online.**
- **Scanning Services:** We will scan articles for you, make sure they are ADA compliant, and upload to ANGEL if you would like.
- **Research Tutorials and Quizzes** (already developed and available through ANGEL).
- **Library instruction:** Embed a librarian in your class or request an online research guide (LibGuide) that can be used from semester to semester.

Films On Demand

- FMG Films On Demand allows for streaming server access of educational videos as produced by Films Media Group (Films for the Humanities & Sciences, Cambridge Educational, Meridian Education, & Shopware.)
- There is a new way to embed these into ANGEL to make viewing more seamless for students. Ask Logan Rath for additional help.

Ebrary

- A new ebook subscription with over 50,000 titles.
- You can access this through the direct link on the library webpage, OR
- When you search on a topic in the library catalog, they will appear as eBooks.
