Motivation and Capacity for Entering the Profession of Social Work

Effective social workers must have strong intellectual ability, skills for abstract thinking, and competence in written and verbal communication. The following questions give you an opportunity to (1) express your motivation for a career in social work, and (2) demonstrate your thinking skills and communication abilities

Type your responses to each of the 4 questions and attach to the application form. Format your responses with a header to include your name in the left-hand corner and the page number in the right-hand corner. Number pages sequentially in the form “1 of 5,” “2 of 5”, etc. Clearly identify the question you are answering. Double-space your responses.

It is crucial that your essays are a reflection of your writing. Therefore, the essays should not be edited or reviewed by others. Using your computer for spell-check and grammar-check is acceptable.

1. Motivation to enter social work:
 - a) Briefly state your three (3) main reasons for wishing to enter the social work profession.
 - b) State three (3) goals which you feel a BSW degree will help you to attain.

2. All human beings have strengths and resources, as well as limitations and barriers which determine the ease with which they can reach their life goals.
 - a) List at least three (3) strengths and resources you possess that you feel will help you to become a good social worker. State how they will help you.
 - b) List at least three (3) limitations or barriers that you face which might hinder you in becoming a good social worker. State how they might hinder you and what you are doing, or plan to do, to overcome these limitations.

3. Social workers frequently have to deal with stressful situations. We all encounter difficult situations from time to time. Briefly describe a recent stressful situation that you encountered and explain how you handled it.
4. Write an original essay addressing the following questions: What problem do you think is the most significant problem in the United States today? Why do you think it's the most significant social problem? What, if anything, do you think social workers should do about it? (Limit your response to 300-500 words.)
