## MANDATORY IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIREMENT

*BEFORE CLASSES BEGIN: All new, re-admitted and transfer undergraduate and graduate students regardless of number of credit hours taken must provide proof.*

*Students will be de-registered and not permitted to attend classes without immunization records. The Registrar will charge a fee to re-register the classes.*

- #1. 2 Doses of **MMR**: Documentation of immunity to Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- ❖ Obtain a copy of your immunization records from your health care provider, high school, or a previous college and **UPLOAD** at [brockport.medicatconnect.com](http://brockport.medicatconnect.com) OR mail or fax the records.

- #2. **Meningitis**:
- Date of meningitis shot OR
  - Review the information and decline the vaccine online
  - ❖ *Students living on campus are recommended to receive the meningitis vaccine.*
