Hiring Associate Faculty
and

Extra Service Payments to Regular Faculty

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

**Regular faculty**: Full time tenured or tenure-track faculty appointed to one of the following titles: Instructor, Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Professor, or Distinguished Professor.

### Associate Faculty:

- (a) Full time non-tenure-track faculty appointed to one of the following titles: Lecturer, Visiting Assistant Professor, Visiting Associate Professor, Visiting Professor, Clinical Assistant Professor, Clinical Associate Professor, Clinical Professor.
- (b) Part time (paid) or Volunteer (unpaid) faculty appointed as Associate Faculty
- (c) SUNY Brockport Emeriti

## Salary ranges for Full Time Associate Faculty

Full time Associate Faculty appointments will be used only when a full time tenure track (Regular) faculty position is unavailable or does not meet the needs of the department or College.

Academic year salaries will be calculated at a rate of up to 85% or equivalent rank\* of full-time tenure track salaries - a 12 credit hour teaching load per semester will be assumed.

\*must be at least the minimum of the salary range.

Any variation from these salary ranges must be approved by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

# Salaries for Part Time Associate Faculty

The following Associate Faculty salaries are for instructional assignments:

- \$800 per credit hour for those with Masters degree
- \$800 per credit hour for those with doctorate or other terminal degree (e.g., MFA or JD)
- \$800 per credit hour for Summer and Winter session courses
- \$1,000 per credit hour for SUNY Brockport emeritus professors (includes Fall or Spring semesters and Winter or Summer Session courses).

\*Maximum course load for part time Associate Faculty is three courses per semester.

## Other salaries

- \$500 per student for student teacher supervision for whole semester (\$250 per student for one quarter)
- \$800 per contact hour for laboratory instruction
- \$1,000 per credit hour for full time Regular faculty who teach Summer and Winter session courses.

# Extra Service Compensation for Full time Regular and Full Time Associate Faculty:

All requests for extra compensation above base salary must be approved by the Provost through the use of an Extra Service Form.

- \$800 per credit hour for full time SUNY Brockport faculty to teach an extra course beyond a full time teaching load (must be approved by the department chair, dean and provost).
- \$200 per week when a full time faculty member fills in for another faculty member on an emergency basis when the obligation exceeds 2 weeks.

All approvals for extra service, also-receives or temporary service must have the account number to be charged.

Exceptions to any of the above guidelines must be approved in writing by the dean and provost.
