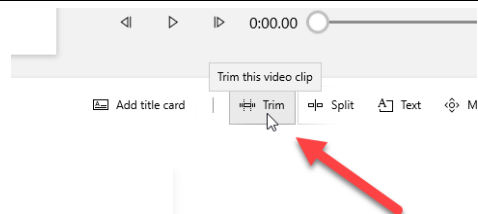

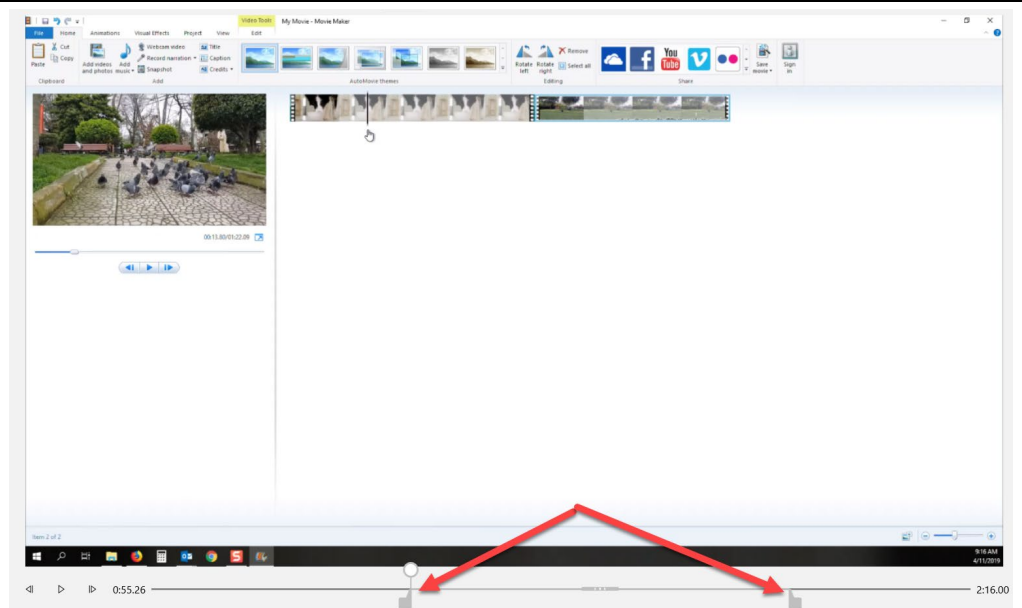
5) Drag-and-drop your video file from the Project Library to the Storyboard



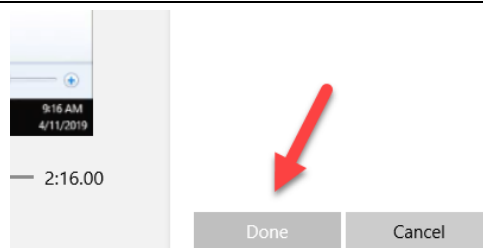
6) Click on the "Trim" button



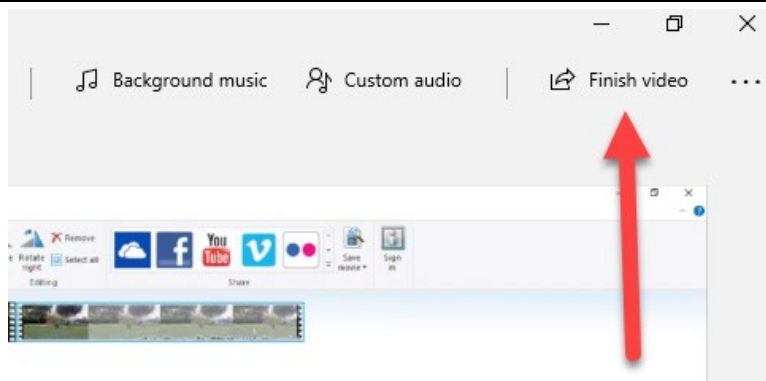
7) Click-and-drag the icons at the beginning and end of your clip to define where you want the new video to start and end.



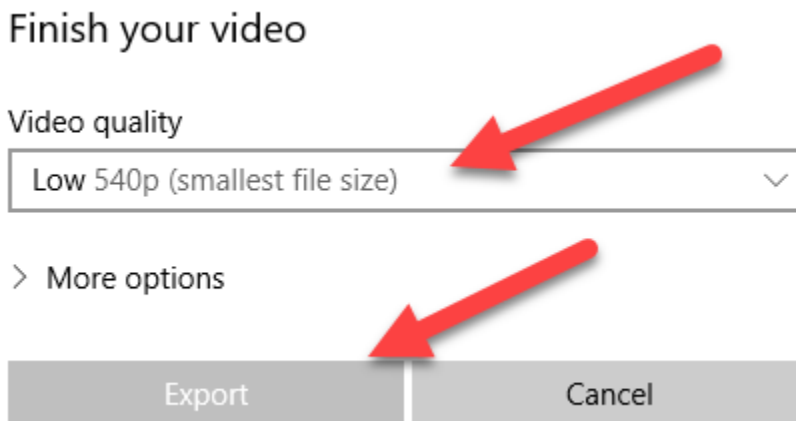
8) Click on the "done" button in the bottom-right corner of the screen



9) Click on the “Finish Video” button in the top-right corner of the screen

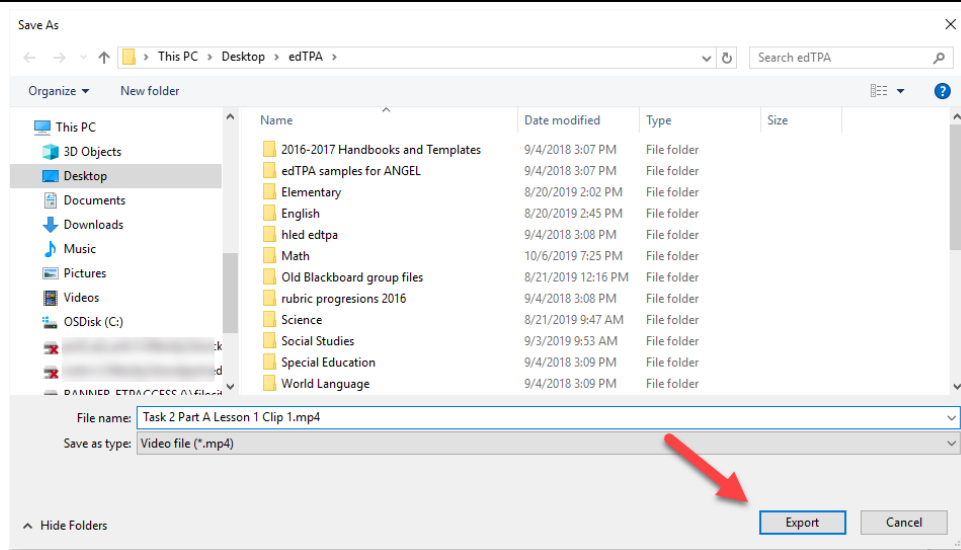


10) Select the “Low” video quality option, and then click on the “Export” button
